

Audax Report

After 2 years of disruption, we held the Cheltenham Flyer 200 again on 19th March 2022, with supporting 100 and 150km events. This provides good use of event HQ, Andoversford VH. Over the 3 events, from 100 entries, we had 77 finishers. This resulted in income over costs of around £300. In the current European crisis, the Committee agreed this go to the Ukraine appeal fund, which I arranged within the C&CCC fund-raising event. I arranged Control support from local communities, which required no Club volunteers. Brian Rainbow, Rupert Harris and daughter Holly covered the Event HQ kitchen, previously run by my wife.

My big disappointment is the number of Cheltenham entries. The 3 events offer a ride in superb countryside that any regular club rider can enjoy.
